## Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research of the Republic of Guinea and GESCI sign Memorandum of Understanding.

On 16<sup>th</sup> March ,2016 an MOU, set to run for 3 years was signed in Dakar, Senegal by GESCI's Chief Executive Officer, Jerome Morrissey and the Chief of Staff Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research of Guinea (MoHESR), Republic of Guinea, Mme Cherif Zeinab CAMARA.

- Coordinate efforts to achieve goals and objectives attracted by a common agreement;
- Identify areas and means to integrate Information Communication and Technology and make a significant contribution to the transformation of Higher Education and Scientific Research by developing the skills of Senior officials and managers;
- Mobilize jointly actors and partners National, regional and The initiatives adopted;
- Share and promote good practices between the two Institutions and among others Actors and stakeholders;
